

## 24 sept 25 MATERIALS LIST FOR DRAWING

Table cover [eg plastic sheet ,newspapers]

Overall /apron if you wish.

Soft Pencils in a range eg 2b,4b,6b

Something bolder to draw with eg Charcoal/charcoal pencils/hard pastel sticks/ big graphite stick in dark cols. Inexpensive is fine, check out the bargain shops/Home direct in Teignmouth/the Works

[plus Soft rubber/Putty rubber for charcoal.]

[ not essential but you may like...Very Fine [black or brown] felt pen [eg finelinerfrom stationers] water soluble ideally not permanent and bring a round brush eg size 6 upwards or similar] and yogurt pot for water.

Drawing pad of approx a3 size of reasonably thick cartridge paper . [we may want to add water]

A larger board to lean on, masking tape or clips

A dark ink of any kind. [big black drawing ink at £3 approx at hobbycraft is best value.

Black quink is exciting becos it splits into two colours]

Kitchen towel/Baby wipes for mucky paws!

So we have a range of items to draw please bring 3 interesting items [natural/ornamental] to add to mine,from small to as big as you can carry!
