

MATERIALS LIST FOR GOUACHE & INK

GENERAL

Table cover,

Overall [this could be a little messy!] and mask

Scissors

Small yogurt pot or similar for ink

Small sponge [kitchen pan scourer plus sponge is ideal]

PAPER

Rough textured water colour paper at least 140lb/300gram [it has to take a lot of water so must be this thick to work] Several sheets of at least a4 size

Some scrap paper to plan on, eg photocopier or drawing paper

INK

This specifically has to be Indian ink or permanent ink [Frisk drawing ink,£3.50 for 150ml at Hobby craft ,Kingsteignton is a good buy]

PAINT

This technique is stunning in black and white but some subjects you may prefer to tint with glazes of thin colour.

You will need.....

Specifically White gouache [opaque water based paint]. White acrylic also works but not as well.

If you wish to tint your pictures bring a selection of watercolours/coloured pencils/acrylics/felt pens that you have

BRUSHES

Soft water colour type brushes [acrylic fibres are fine]

At least a pointed one ,say in approx size 6, a small square headed one approx 1cm wide

A robust brush eg diy one of 1-2" or similar

[Bring any other brushes you have too]

BOARD

Stiff board bigger than yr paper eg mdf,ply, drawing board

Masking tape

INSPIRATION

This technique produces a wood cut like picture. If you have any objects or reference photos that would be suitable subjects, pls bring them.
